Rules and Regulations:

1. Costumes must be in good taste and appropriate for a family event. All costumes that are deemed inappropriate by the judges will be disqualified.
2. Costumes do not have to be homemade but judges prefer to see effort in thought and design.
3. Costumes must be self contained and in need of no electrical outlets.
4. Judges for costume contest are not eligible to compete.
5. All costumes must be registered and signed in at the front of the Roxy by 4:30pm on Oct 31. You can sign in as early as 3:30pm.
6. All awards will be given at the end of the event. Contestants must be present to win.
7. The judges have the sole authority to choose the winners. They will however take into account audience response. Judges decisions are final.
8. Minors must have a parent or legal guardian signature on their registration form.
9. By registering you agree to allow the City of Clarksville Parks and Recreation along with The Roxy Regional Theater to use their images or video for promotional purposes.
